

**WATER BAPTISM INSTRUCTIONS**  
(Print this card and keep for reference)

**Matthew 28:19 (NASB)**

<sup>19</sup> "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,"

**What to expect:** To be baptized in water means to be fully immersed in water. The word baptize in the Greek (baptizo) means to make wholly wet; immerse; sink; plunge; to dip under. It appears 80 times in the New Testament. Expect to be completely submerged in the water which signifies your identification with the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ.

- **Acts 8:36-38 (NASB)**

<sup>36</sup> As they went along the road they came to some water; and the eunuch said\*, "**Look! Water! What prevents me from being baptized?**"

<sup>37</sup> And Phillip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."

<sup>38</sup> And he ordered the chariot to stop; and **they both went down into the water**, Phillip as well as the eunuch, and he **baptized** him.

- **Mark 1:9-10 (NASB)**

<sup>9</sup> In those days Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan.(river)

<sup>10</sup> Immediately **coming up out of the water**, He saw the heavens opening, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon Him;

**What to bring:** Towel, a change of clothing, a bag to put your wet things, flip-flop slippers (optional)

**What to wear:** Dark colored clothing, sweat suits, dark and loose fitting t-shirts

**What NOT to wear:** Bathing suits, any light colored and revealing clothing, shorts.
